PARKING

NO SCHOOL PARKING PASSES WILL BE ISSUED

Limited parking will be available in lots 60 and 76. Permit can be obtained from the lot attendant for \$10, Credit or Debit ONLY. Parking on the grass or in restricted areas is prohibited and will result in a citation and possible tow. There is limited parking available for buses. If needed, Lot 45 on Dayton St has 4 stalls for bus parking (east side of campus).

FOOD SERVICE
