

SECTION 7 INFRACTIONS ILLEGAL HEADLOCK

Rule 7-1-5d any headlock in which the arms or hands are locked around the opponents's head without encircling an arm (elbow or above)



"It is the elbow, or shoulder encircled that allows a headlock to be legal, because it blocks the pressure on the neck and carotid artery. It is important to note all headlocks are considered potentially dangerous."
